5 USEFUL TIPS

1 ACCOMMODATION

- Stay in Eixample or El Born – central & walkable

2 TICKETS

- Book Sagrada Familia + Park Güell online (5-7 days in advance!)

BOOK NOW

3 TRANSPORT

- Use T-Casual Metro Card (10 rides) – best value

4 TIME-SAVING

- Go at 9:00 AM – avoid crowds

- Carry water + sunscreen

Buy Montjüic Cable Car tickets online to skip queues

Barcelona is very walkable –
• combine metro + walking instead of taxis
- 4 Food tip** 
Avoid restaurants directly on La Rambla – go 1–2 streets away for better prices & quality
- 5 Best time tip** 
Best months to visit:
May–June or September
