## **Dress code**

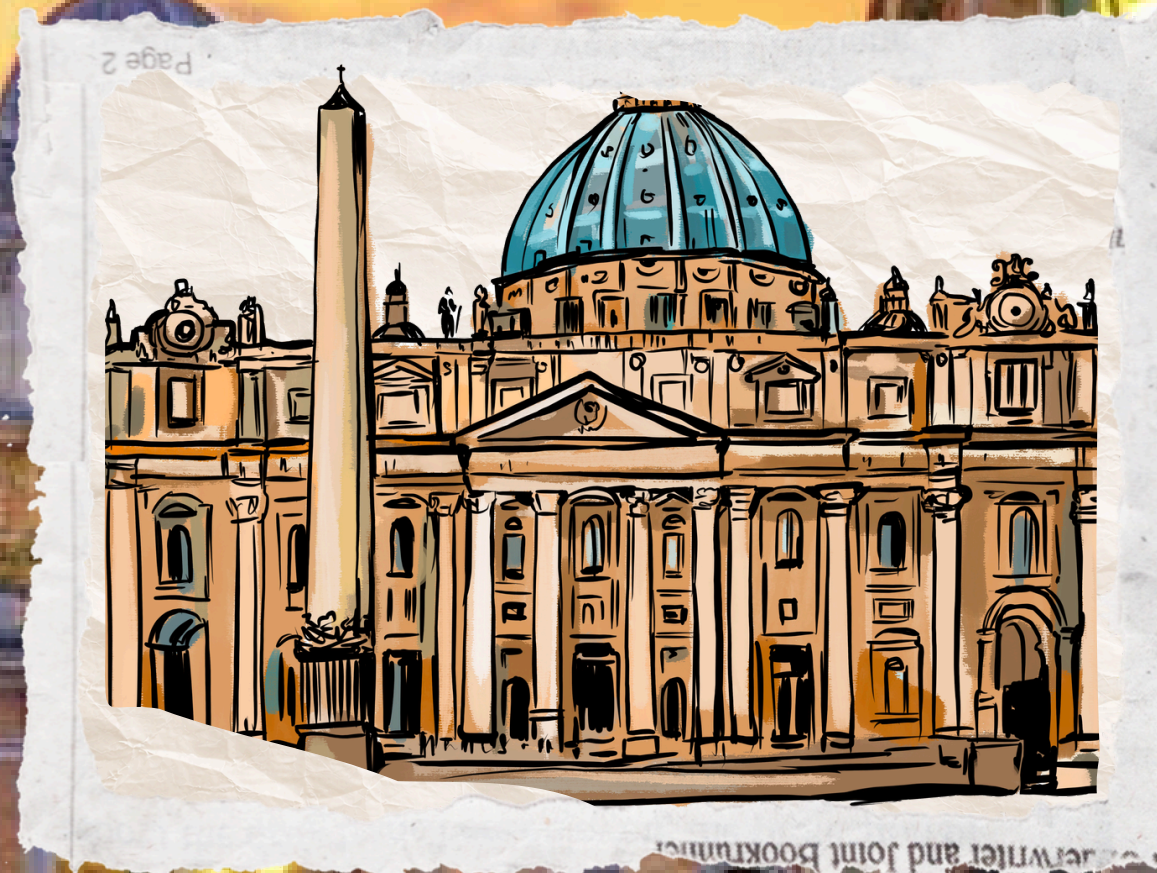
- At the Vatican, wear covered shoulders and knees.
